

Privacy Policy

CommPartners ("Company") will not trade, sell, or disclose to any third party any form of subscriber identifiable information without the consent of the subscriber (except as required by subpoena, search warrant or other legal process or in the case where failure to disclose information will lead to imminent harm to the subscriber or others). This includes information derived from registration, subscription, and use of the Company's service.

Collection / Use of Information

The Company will collect and use subscriber identifiable information for billing, provisioning of service, resolution of problems associated with service, 411 type directory services, and to inform subscribers of new products or services that will enhance the Company's ability to provide service to subscribers.
